Luther Charles Wilson, a proud San Francisco native, was born to Cedric Wilson and Ruth Avist-Wilson. Raised in a family rich in musical heritage and deep spiritual roots, Luther began singing at the tender age of three in the Sunshine Band at New Hope Missionary Baptist Church, where his great-grandfather, the late Reverend Ivory G. Wilson, faithfully served as Senior Pastor. Gifted with a remarkable ear for music, he soon learned to play the keyboard, organ, and bass guitar—demonstrating early both discipline and divine gifting.

From a young age, Luther's love for God was unmistakable. As he cultivated his musical talents, his spiritual maturity blossomed. By fourteen, he was praying and preaching on Youth Sundays, revealing not only a call to ministry but a heart surrendered to the service of the Lord Jesus Christ. It became evident to all who encountered him that God's hand was upon his life for a greater purpose.

Following the Lord's leading, Luther joined Sonlight Christian Center in Richmond, California, under the leadership of Dr. C.E. Daggs. There, he faithfully served as Minister of Music and Choir Director, later expanding his ministry as Worship Leader and Pastor of Worship in various respected ministries. With humility and excellence, he has used his gifts to glorify God—lifting the name of Jesus through preaching, worship, and song. His ministry reflects both intellectual depth and spiritual discernment, always grounded in Scripture and guided by wisdom.

On January 1, 2014, he was appointed Assistant Pastor under Bishop C.E. Daggs and was ordained as an Elder. In August 2017, he was installed as Senior Pastor of Sonlight Christian Center. Pastor Luther continues to lead with vision, integrity, and a servant's heart—committed to advancing the Kingdom of God with clarity, compassion, and conviction.

He has appeared on numerous radio programs, podcasts, and television broadcasts, officiated weddings and home-going services nationwide, and shared platforms with notable gospel artists and ministry leaders. Yet his greatest honor remains serving Christ and His people with excellence and humility.

On February 26, 2026, Pastor Luther entered into one of the greatest blessings of his life—marrying his beloved wife, Lady Camille Wilson. Their union stands as a testimony of God's faithfulness, grace, and divine timing. Overflowing with joy and gratitude, Pastor Luther embraces both marriage and ministry with wisdom, strength, and unwavering devotion to Christ.

He continues spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ throughout the world, living out his life's mission as a servant of the Lord. His favorite scripture, Romans 8:28, anchors his faith:

"And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are called according to his purpose."

Camille attended Gardena Valley Christian School, where she accepted Christ at an early age. At the age of ten, she publicly declared her faith and was baptized at Double Rock Baptist Church in Compton, California.

There, she poured into the lives of others by teaching Children's Church, serving as an usher, leading devotionals on the Women's Prayer Line, and ministering through music as a member of the Praise Team, Sanctuary Choir, and Youth Choir.

In addition to her dedication to ministry, Camille has devoted nearly fifteen years of service as a public servant for the State of California, serving across multiple departments. Her commitment to public service reflects her heart for helping others and making a meaningful impact both inside and outside of the church.

She served as Music Coordinator for four years, helping to nurture and organize the music ministry. Dr. KEVIN HALL

Pastor Kevin B. Hall is God's visionary for the historical St. John Missionary Baptist Church. Known as, "A Kingdom Building Church In Two Communities" (St. Matthew 28:18-20). St. John is one of the largest churches in Richmond, California. Serving as the Spiritual Leader since July 29, 1994, Pastor Hall heeded the guidance of the Holy Spirit to take St. John to higher heights by leading the church in their spiritual walk with Christ Jesus. Although the congregation has grown tremendously over the past 28 years, Pastor Hall's focus is not "membership driven," but "discipleship driven." His passion for the lost souls of this world compelled him to preach every Sunday for three consecutive years 2006-2008. Week after week, his uncompromisingly bold preaching and teaching of God's Word transformed and converted the hearts of many to choose Jesus Christ as their personal Savior and Lord.

God has given Pastor Hall a vision for His people. With a Ministerial Staff consisting of many preachers (including pastors) and many ministries dedicated to serving the parishioners and surrounding communities, he continues to equip the saints for future service unto the Lord. Through the leadership of Pastor Hall, St. John has realized several major milestones such as the acquisition of the Administration Building located in downtown Richmond; a multi-million-dollar renovation and beautification project enhancing our South Campus Worship Center and erecting the Kevin B. Hall Education Building on that site. St. John acquired an additional Worship Center, St. John North Campus, located in downtown Richmond. This is the site where the St. John Outreach Ministry was established in 2013. The Kevin B. Hall Education Building (North Campus) consists of 15 classrooms, where Disciples of Christ are thriving and being equipped and where the St. John School of Theology was also established in 2014 with Pastor Hall serving as Director/Instructor. The St. John School Of Theology partnered with the Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary of Marin, CA. Pastor Hall taught such courses as, Introduction to Christian Theology, Ministry Foundations, Communicating The Gospel and Missions, Evangelism & Church Planting.

We are now challenged with elevating our ministry to impact a larger scope of people with a "Mission-Minded-Focus." Most recently, Pastor Hall led the church to purchase land in two locations for future development. With the recent acquisition of new development property near the St. John North Campus, we are expanding our facilities to fulfill our mission as "A Kingdom Building Church In Two Communities." At the North Campus, we are about to begin the construction of a multi-million-dollar Family Life Center which will consist of a gymnasium, weight room and game room.

Educationally, Pastor Hall earned a Bachelor of Arts Degree (Philosophy as his major and Sociology as his minor) from San Francisco State University in 1983. He also earned a Bachelor of Theology Degree from Conroe Bible College that same year. In 1987, Pastor Hall earned a Master of Divinity Degree and a Master of Religious Education from the Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary. On May 25, 1996, Pastor Hall received his Doctor of Ministry Degree from San Francisco Theological Seminary in San Anselmo, California.

Pastor Hall has achieved many triumphs during his 43 years of dedicated service to the Master. He was also the pastor of St. Mark Baptist Church in San Francisco for 7 ½ years before becoming the pastor of St. John. He is an honored member of the National Directory of WHO'S WHO in Executives and Professionals. He has received many Awards and Certificates of Recognition for outstanding church and community leadership from officials in the City of San Francisco, City of Richmond and the State of California.

Pastor Hall is the devoted son of Reverend John L. Hall and the late Mrs. Ola Mae Hall. He is the proud father of two children, Kevin (Shana) and Kavina (Phillip) and grandfather of Kalayah, Kaelyn, Micah, Myla, and Myielle. Pastor Hall can always be found reciting these words of encouragement, "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct thy paths" (Proverbs 3:5-6).
